Here is where to file your claim based on the source of your damage:

- 💧 Overflow from a body of water?
- 💧 Sprinkler system?
- 💧 Rapid accumulation of rain?
- 💧 Water main break?
- 💧 Bursting pipe?
- 💧 Hurricane?
- 💧 Sewer or drain back-up?
- 💧 Sewer or drain back-up resulting from a flood?
- 💧 Melting snow and ice?
- 💧 Fire hydrant?
- 💧 Mudflow (*flowing mud on normally dry land*)?
- 💧 Rain damage after a tornado?
- 💧 Building collapse resulting from flood erosion?
